**Salary:**

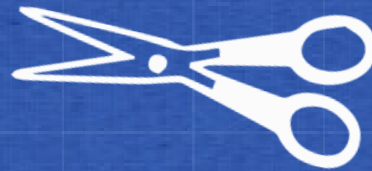
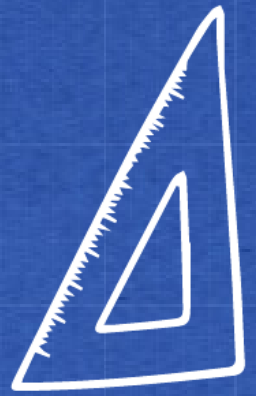
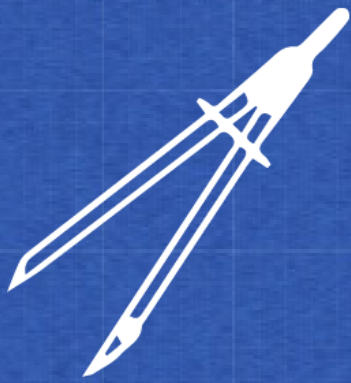
